INTRODUCTION

The defendant has been married to the Complainant since 2007: they separated following the birth of their daughter in December 2022 ...

They have one 3 month old daughter together: this child has not been present for any Family Harm incidents.

There have been no previously recorded family harm incidents between the defendant and his estranged wife.

On Tuesday 11, April 2023 , a Temporary Protection Order was issued from the PORIRUA District Court, the respondent being the defendant and protected person being the complainant in this matter. Other orders issued (Reference FAM-2023-091-000115) included an Occupancy Order and ancillary Furniture Order.

These orders were served by Police to the defendant on 12th April 2023 at 17 Princeton Road, Raumati beach.

Initially, the defendant was given a period of grace to arrange to go to the address of a relative in wellington. This was extended by the victim who waited for the defendant's father to return from overseas to assist the defendant move on 25th April 2023.

CIRCUMSTANCES

At about 11:30 AM on Wednesday 26th April 2023 the defendant SOLT was at 17 Princeton Road, Raumati Beach, Kapiti Coast, PARAPARAUMU.

Police attended the address along with the father of the defendant who was there to give this defendant one last chance to move of his own accord (assisted by his father)

It was made clear to the defendant (by police) that he could leave freely with his father but if he refused to leave he would be arrested for contravening the Protection Order and removed from the address by police.

The defendant refused to leave and was arrested by police and removed from the address.

DEFENDANT'S COMMENTS

In explanation the defendant stated that Defendant stated the Protection Order was inappropriate as he was not dangerous.

The defendant has not previously appeared before the Court.

I, Amanda Kathleen Louise WARD, state:

1. I was married to David SOLT in 2007.
2. I own a property at 17 Princeton Road, Raumati Beach that we lived in.
3. I had moved out of the address in December 2022. David remained at the address.
4. In February 2022 we separated. I requested that David leave the house by 16 March so I could move back in with our baby.
5. He refused to leave, and I attempted to trespass him. This did not work, so I advised him and his parents I would go to the Family Court as my next step.
6. On 11 April 2023 I was granted a Protection Order; an Occupancy Order and Ancillary Furniture Order, listing David SOLT as the Respondent.
7. I was kept informed by police in relation to the service of these orders and was advised by Detective Niall Deehan and Constable Shane Patience that these orders had been served on the Respondent.
8. Part of my application listed to the court details the Respondents medical condition.
9. I was aware that David's mother was visiting from Europe and his father was in China.
10. David refused to vacate the property when requested to do so on 13th April: I agreed to defer asking him to leave until his father returned from China on 25th April

11. On 25th April I was made aware that David was refusing to leave the address with the help of his father.
12. On 26th April 2023, I advised Detective DEEHAN that I wished for him to leave the property and my discretion of not invoking the orders earlier was now at an end.
13. I authorised Detective DEEHAN to request on my behalf that David leave the property.
14. I am aware that he has medical conditions however he has used these conditions to justify his behaviour for years.
15. Having previously relaxed my position on the Orders that were granted to me by the court: I was left with no option but to enforce the orders so I could return home with our child.
16. I did this knowing that David has accessible alternate accommodation with a family member and this accommodation has been available to him.

I confirm the truth and accuracy of this statement. I make the statement with the knowledge that it is to be used in court proceedings. I am aware that it is an offence to make a statement that is known by me to be false or intended by me to mislead.

The informant and victim for this episode has been identified as Amanda WARD, due to disclosures made by her.

The parties involved in this family harm episode have been identified as Amanda WARD and David SOLT. They were married for 15 years, however they separated in February 2022.

They have one biological daughter, 3 month old Lily SOLT.

They do not reside together.

Amanda and Lily have been staying at [REDACTED] as David refuses to leave the address for which she has an occupancy order.

David lives at 17 PRINCETON ROAD.

There is a Protection Order in place with the Applicant being named as WARD, Amanda and the Respondent named as SOLT, David.

Today Amanda called police for assistance with getting David to leave the address as per Court Orders.

Police spoke with David's father Paul who wanted a chance to get David to voluntarily leave the address. Police agreed to let Paul try this and advised him of the consequences if David was not compliant.

Upon police arrival David could be heard yelling at his father who was standing in the back door of this property. Police entered the house and spoke with David. Police advised David that he was breaching the Protection Order and Occupancy Order by not leaving the address when requested to. Police asked David to voluntarily leave the address, however he refused to leave. Due to David refusing to leave the address voluntarily, police arrested him for Breach of Protection Order.

The parties involved in this family harm episode have been identified as Victim and Predominant aggressor.

The victim of this family harm episode has been identified as Amanda WARD, due to statements made by her to Kapiti family harm team, Detective Niall DEEHAN.

Amanda stated that:

She was married to David SOLT in 2007, however they separated in February 2022.

She owns the property at 17 Princeton Road, Raumati Beach that they lived in together, before separating.

She requested that David leave the house by the 16th March 2023, so she could move back in with their baby.

David refused to leave, so she attempted to trespass him.

She went to the Family Court and on the 11th April 2023 was granted a Protection Order, Occupancy Order and Ancillary Furniture Order listing David SOLT as the respondent.

She was advised by the Kapiti Family Harm team that these orders had been served on the Respondent.

On the 13th of April 2023 David refused to vacate the property when requested to do so.

She deferred asking David to leave again until the 25th of April 2023 as his father would be back in the country at this time.

She was made aware on the 25th of April 2023 that David was refusing to leave the address with the help of his father.

On the 26th April 2023, She advised the Kapiti Family Harm Team that she wished for David to leave the property and her discretion of not invoking the orders earlier was now at an end.

She authorised Detective Niall DEEHAN to request on her behalf that David leave the property.

She did this knowing that David has access able alternate accommodation with family members.

Predominant Aggressor / Offender:

The predominant aggressor of this family harm episode has been identified as David SOLT due to a statement made by the victim Amanda WARD, as well as being present and refusing to leave the property when asked to by police.

Upon police arrival David could be heard yelling at his father who was standing in the back door of this property. Police entered the house and spoke with David. Police advised David that he was breaching the Protection Order and Occupancy Order by not leaving the address when requested to. Police asked David to voluntarily leave the address, however he refused to leave.

Kapiti Family harm team attempted to engage with David who declined to voluntarily vacate the property. Police explained clearly to David that he would be arrested if he did not leave on his own, David acknowledged that he understood that he would be arrested if he refused to leave.

David consciously decided he would not leave the address and was arrested by police.

Lily is the only child of the couple and she is a baby aged 3 months. She was not present during this family harm episode. Police have no concerns for the welfare of this child in the care of her mother

Police along with David's father SOLT, Paul went to the address to speak with David and communicate to him that there is a Court Order in place ordering him to vacate the property 17 Princeton Road, Raumati Beach.

Paul tried to engage with his son with no success.

Police attempted to engage with David SOLT who declined to voluntarily vacate the property. Police explained clearly to David that he would be arrested if he did not leave on his own, David acknowledged that he understood that he would be arrested if he refused to leave.

David consciously decided he would not leave the address and was arrested by police.

A PSO was not considered due to David being arrested and charged with Contravenes a Protection Order.
